



## Springfield in Full Bloom Checklist

### April

- Edge around sidewalks and driveways
- Aerate lawns
- Seed bare lawn areas
- Review your lawn fertilizer program
- Mulch and weed flower beds
- Plant flower and vegetable seeds after the last frost

### May

- Complete mulching and weeding flower beds
- Plant annuals
- Power wash siding and other external features
- Clean windows
- Touch up paint on external property
- Clean patio furniture and landscape art
- Trim conifer trees
- Remove dead trees and bushes
- Remove unnecessary signage and objects surrounding properties
- Treat lawn with herbicides, as recommended
- Pick up loose branches and sticks in yard

### June/July

- Display and maintain floral hanging baskets
- Trim hedges
- Maintain rock beds and water features
- Deadhead annuals
- Prune bushes and perennials
- Use sprinklers to ensure healthy grass growth

### Ongoing

- Mow your lawns
- Pull weeds
- Sweep sidewalks and driveways
- Clean out ash trays and appropriately dispose of cigarette litter
- Replace lighting as necessary
